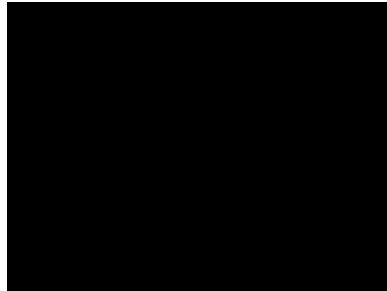

- 18 preparing for waves 5-6 – 71 out of 150
- 19 projects in procurement
- 14 ITN issued
- 8 projects at Preferred Bidder stage
- Bristol reached FC and formed first LEP
- Academy procurement now within PfS

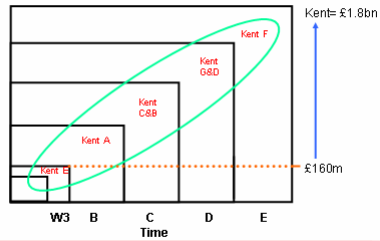
