### 3 STEPS AND A FEW MINUTES TO *DOWNLOADING*

(You need to have **logged in** to your account to download programmes to your computer or other storage devices)

1. When logged in, right click on the 'Windows Media' or 'Quicktime' button that appears next to your selected programme
2. Select 'save target as ...'
3. Your programme will be downloaded to your chosen location. View when and where you want

(downloading times will vary depending on the speed of your internet connection)

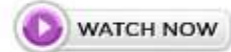
